BOARD GAME

SETTING UP

Set up the board in the centre of the table, slot in all the pieces of the puzzle. The order doesn't matter, that way no game is ever the same. Put the box together by inserting the sides into the hexagonal plastic base and then put the picture cards inside. Give each player three round chips of the same colour. Choose a leader and one of the game formats, A or B. And... get ready, the game's about to begin!

GAMF A

In this option, the leader can also play. The leader deals each player 3 picture cards face down. Once the pre-agreed signal is given, the game begins. Players look at their cards and look for the matching pictures on the board. When they find them a coloured chip must be put on top of each picture. The first player to find all 3 pictures shouts "Stop!". Play is immediately halted and the other players must stop looking for their pictures.

Once the pictures and chips have been checked, each player collects the picture cards they've found. The others are put back into the box and the cards are shuffled. The coloured chips are then removed from the board. The leader deals each player 3 new cards and a new round begins. This continues until one player has collected 25 picture cards or there are no cards left. And so on. The first player to win the most cards wins.

GAME B

In this option, each player receives a different coloured chip. The leader (who can't play in this option) chooses a card from the box and shows the players who must then locate the picture on the board. The first to locate the picture puts their chip on top of it.

Play is halted, the player removes their chip and wins the card. The first player to win 15 cards wins.

PENALTIES

- If a player puts the wrong chip on the board, they must return that picture card and the one they had previously won. These are put back in the box.
- If a player repeatedly obstructs the board they will be penalised. They can choose either to return a card to the box or sit out the following round.
